**SOUTH PIER INVESTMENTS AND QUASIUS CONSTRUCTION BREAK GROUND ON SOUTH PIER RIVERFRONT CONDOS**

*Luxury condos will complete Sheboygan South Pier redevelopment and provide riverfront living for residents*

November 7, 2019, Sheboygan, WI – Construction of Sheboygan’s newest luxury condominium, South Pier River Front Condo’s, is officially under way. Quasius Construction broke ground on the new building in late October, and celebrated the start of construction of the new 21-unit building located on South Pier Drive, at Illinois Ave November 7<sup>th</sup> with an official ceremony.

The four-story luxury condo building helps to answer the City of Sheboygan’s need for additional housing. The condominium building will feature seven (7) unique two-bedroom, two-bath layouts for owners to choose from and a range of interior finishes ranging from contemporary modern to nautical design. Each unit ranges between 1,330 SF and 1,510 SF.
