SHEBOYGAN COUNTY, WI — The Plymouth Plan Commission approved the expansion of a Sartori Whey Converting facility in early June 2021, which will add over 22,000 square feet to the existing cheese plant. Sartori Cheese is converted and packaged at this facility before being shipped to specialty cheese shops, grocery stores, restaurants, and food manufacturers all around the world.

The plant sits along County Road PP in Plymouth, WI and is currently 83,854 square feet. Abacus Architects presented the plans for the expansion. Construction began in the Spring of 2021, and the project is scheduled to be completed in November 2021.

Sartori Cheese is a family-owned company that specializes in award-winning artisan cheese. The company has been making cheese since 1939, honoring Italian traditions while also welcoming the innovation and creativity of its employees.
