Packers season opener against New Orleans on Sunday, September 12

<u>United Airlines</u> is offering a nonstop flight from GRB to <u>Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport (MSY)</u> on Saturday, Sept. 11 at 5:45 p.m., arriving in New Orleans at 8:41 p.m. The nonstop return flight is Monday, Sept. 12 leaving New Orleans at 8:30 a.m., arriving in Green Bay at 11:00 a.m.

Packers in San Francisco on Sunday, September 26

United Airlines is offering a nonstop flight to <u>San Francisco International Airport (SFO)</u> on Saturday, Sept. 25, leaving at 5:35 p.m., arriving in San Francisco at 8:25 p.m. The nonstop return flight is Monday, Sept. 27, leaving San Francisco at 8:52 a.m. and arriving at Green Bay at 3:11 p.m.

NEW! Washington at Green Bay on Sunday, October 24

Just added to the nonstop schedule: A nonstop flight from Washington D.C.'s Dulles International Airport (IAD) for the Packers home game vs. the Washington Football Team. The flight leaves IAD at 5:25 p.m. on Saturday, Oct. 23, arriving in Green Bay at 6:37 p.m. On Sunday, the nonstop return flight leaves GRB at 6:18 p.m. and arrives at IAD at 9:20 p.m. "United knows there are a lot of Packers fans in the DC area," added Piette. "It's great that they can make a quick weekend trip to Lambeau to watch the Packers play."

Packers in Minneapolis on Sunday, November 21

<u>Sun Country Airlines</u> has a nonstop flight to <u>Minneapolis–Saint Paul International Airport</u> (MSP) on Sunday, Nov, 21, leaving GRB at 7:00 a.m. and arriving in Minneapolis at 8:15 a.m. The return flight leaves MSP at 8:30 p.m. and arrives in Green Bay at 9:40 p.m.

Minneapolis comes to Green Bay on Sunday, January 2

For Packers fans living in the Twin Cities area or western Wisconsin, it will be easy to make this Sunday night game in Green Bay. The Sun Country nonstop flight from MSP to GRB leaves at noon and arrives in Green Bay at 1:10 p.m.; leaving you plenty of time to join in pre-game tailgating and other festivities before the evening game. The return flight leaves GRB at 12:30 a.m., arriving at MSP at 1:45 a.m.
