Loux holds an undergraduate degree in Business/Economics from Wheaton College and an MBA in Marketing from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Loux has held various leadership positions with JLG Industries, Inc., an Oshkosh Corporation company, Direct Supply, Inc. and Kimberly-Clark Corporation. Loux also serves on the Board of Directors of the Wisconsin Association of Family & Children's Agencies (WAFCA) and on the Advisory Board of InitiativeOne.
