HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION PLANNED IN WAUKESHA COUNTY

County Trunk Highway D

Moraine Hills Drive Intersection

(WAUKESHA, WI) – Construction is scheduled to begin on the Waukesha County Public Works pavement resurfacing project CTH D at the Moraine Hills Drive intersection in the town of Ottawa. Work is scheduled to start July 17th weather permitting. This 1000-foot length project will consist of milling and replacement of asphalt surface, application of a High Friction Surface Treatment (HFST), pavement marking and improved signage. Construction activities will require approximately two weeks to complete. The construction project will be administered by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) as part of the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP).

CTH D will be reduced to one lane in each direction under flagging operations, so motorists should expect delays and are encouraged to seek alternative routes.
