




OVERALL - WOMEN AND CHILDREN RANK: 22

STRENGTHS

- High voter participation among women
- High prevalence of women with a dedicated health care provider
- Low prevalence of physical inactivity among women

CHALLENGES

- High prevalence of anxiety among children
- High prevalence of excessive drinking among women
- Low percentage of children with adequate and continuous health insurance

HIGHLIGHTS

- Cigarette smoking during pregnancy decreased 39% from 11.3% to 6.9% of women with a live birth between 2016 and 2021.
- Teen births decreased 33% from 15.0 to 10.1 births per 1,000 females ages 15-19 between 2016 and 2021.
- Drug deaths increased 22% from 23.4 to 28.5 deaths per 100,000 women ages 20-44 between 2016-2018 and 2019-2021.
- Injury deaths increased 14% from 41.6 to 47.6 deaths per 100,000 women ages 20-44 between 2016-2018 and 2019-2021.













Injury Deaths - Children

Number of deaths due to injury per 100,000 children ages 1-19











Maternal Mortality

Number of deaths related to or aggravated by pregnancy (excluding accidental or incidental causes) occurring within 42 days of the end of a pregnancy per 100,000 live births













Number of infant deaths (before age 1) per 1,000 live births





Number of deaths due to drug injury (unintentional, suicide, homicide or undetermined) per 100,000 females ages 20-44



Births per 1,000 females ages 15-19




