### **TURKEY & PUMPKIN PIE GIVEAWAY AND RESOURCE FAIR AT UNCOM**

On Monday, November 25, 2023, UNCOM will host a FREE Turkey & Pumpkin Pie Giveaway as part of UNCOM's Safer City MKE initiative, from 4-6 pm, or until all the food is distributed, in the South Parking Lot of the Wellness Commons building (1609 W North Ave, Milwaukee). Turkeys and pies will be distributed on a first come, first serve basis. Funding for the turkeys and pies was generously provided by the Forest County Potawatomi Foundation.

Representatives from Equus Workforce Solutions, the UNCOM workforce development team, and the City of Milwaukee - Office Community Wellness & Safety will be on hand to offer employment resources for youth and adults plus violence reduction materials.
