Alex has participated in many pitch competitions and debates in the past; his experience gave him an opportunity to rate high and earn the \$3,000 1st place prize money.

Tyler Heilberger took the \$1,500 second place slot for his unique 'Rosebud' idea. Tyler from Plymouth, WI showcased his family travel software that will help families find unique experiences customized to personal preferences.
